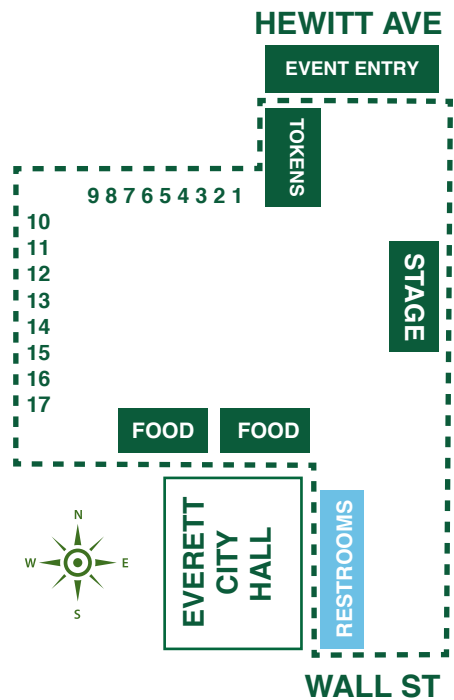

#1 Middleton Brewing - Everett, WA

- 1) Wont Kill You – Imperial Barleywine – ABV 20%
- 2) Blood, Sweat & Beers – Blood Orange Triple IPA – ABV 10.7%
- 3) Mierda Fuego – Jalapeno Pale Ale – ABV: 5%
- 4) Short Pies – Peach-O's Oatmeal Pale Ale – ABV 5%
- 5) That's My Jam! – Strawberry Wheat Ale – ABV 4.2%
- 6) Cha-Cha-Chata – Horchata Hard Seltzer – ABV 4%

#2 Republic Of Cider – Seattle, WA

- 1) Jie Jie – Winter Melon Lemon – ABV 6.7%
- 2) George's Washington Cider – ABV 6.3%

#3 Sound2Summit Brewing – Snohomish, WA

- 1) Double Reef – Double Hazy IPA
- 2) Offshore Saison – Saison Style
- 3) Powder Hungry – Hazy Pale Ale

#4 Sisters' Cider House - Bainbridge, WA

- 1) Sweet Ass Bourbon – ABV 8.5%

A little bit of sweet with a little bit of ass... no jk! This amazing concoction will have you ordering another glass before you've finished your first. As one burley mountain man said.. its like warm socks and fresh biscuits on a cold winter day.

- 2) Strawbanero – ABV 7%

Hawt Damn...this one has a lovely strawberry up front and a subtle habanero in the back. By the time you notice the heat...it's gone.

#5 Lake Stevens Brewing Company - Lake Stevens, WA

- 1) Jucifer – Hazy IPA: ABV 6.3% | 33 IBU

Extra Juicy Hazy IPA

Chocolate peanut butter imperial porter! Think Reese's PB cup but in beer form

- 2) Dublin Up - Irish Stout – ABV 4.4% | IBU 37

Roasty yet creamy smooth. Notes of bittersweet chocolate and a light coffee aroma. When one's not enough, you'll end up Dublin Up!

- 3) Firehouse – Amber: ABV 5.9% | IBU 27

ESB base malt, honey, Willamette hops build a complex yet approachable profile.

#6 Glory Bucha - Arlington, WA

1) Hard Bucha / Peach Hops – ABV: 6%

Made with organic peach concentrate, apple juice, natural hops, Cider

2) Hard Bucha / Pineapple Pizzaz - ABV: 6%

Made with organic pineapple juice, cider

3) Pear & Sage – ABV: 6%

Made with all natural Washington State pears, organic sage, cider

#7 Skookum Brewing - Arlington, WA

1) Last Things First – Hazy IPA – ABV: 6.8%

Notes of melon, lime and pine

2) Pastry Stout – ABV: 8.7%

Brewed with Oreo cookies. Rich and Robust

#8 Shilling Hard Cider – Seattle, WA

1) Local Legend Semi Sweet: 5.2% ABV

This isn't a hoax. The rumors are true. The local legend has been sighted – tasting is believing. After years of safe-guarding and fine-tuning secret family recipes, I am ready to reveal my latest creation. No longer elusive, the perfect harmony of dry and sweet is in your hands. A cider that is as refreshing as a cool mountain creek and doesn't miss a bear. There may be other ciders in the wild, but this Local Legend is worthy of its name. Just like a Sasquatch, this cider is always waiting to be discovered. If you are a believer, come find me in the woods.

2) Big Zesty Guava Lemonade: 6.9% ABV

Schilling's bold entry into the new world of lemonade ciders is nothing short of spectacular. The guava juice adds just a full layer of juiciness that is balanced well with the acidity of the lemon, not too sweet and not too tart.

3) Excelsior Imperial Apple: 8.4% ABV

This cider represents the largest amount of heirloom cider fruit used in any cider brand sold in the USA! Excelsior Imperial Apple boasts wonderful acidity, complex yet smooth. tannins, light molasses/raisin/caramel notes, and a delightful fresh apple aroma. This is the ORIGINAL imperial cider in a 6 pack. It's also by far the best-tasting imperial cider made!

4) Excelsior Imperial Pineapple: 8.4% ABV

Pining for the perfect pairing? Excelsior Pineapple combines our passion-for-fruit with a tantalizing cosmic creation that makes its landing at 8.4% ABV. Start your journey with its vibrant pineapple aroma and let it lead you to your first sip of this celestial cider! The combination of fresh-pressed Pacific Northwest apples, tart passion fruit, and juicy pineapple bursts with the tropical flavor of the getaway you've been daydreaming about.

#9 - VIDA MATÉ – Seattle, WA

1) Blackberry Lemonade

Pacific Northwest blackberry blends with refreshingly tart lemonade

2) Mango Lime

Vibrant mango mixes with a splash of tangy lime

3) Mint Lemonade

Fresh Oregon mint is muddled with zesty fresh lemonade

4) Peach Guava

Sun-ripened peach melds with tropical sweet guava

5) Pineapple Ginger

Juicy pineapple meets the invigorating kick of ginger

#10 Diamond Knot Brewing – Mukilteo, WA

1) Optimistic Thought – Hazy IPA: 6.8% ABV | 60 IBU

Medium to light body, highly aromatic, juicy AF, chinook, columbus, mosaic, and citra hops

2) Northwest Blonde Ale: 4.2% ABV | 13 IBU

Light yet flavorful with a bright, floral aroma and clean finish thanks to a complex malt bill and delicate use of noble hops.

3) Topical London Hazy IPA: 6.4% ABV | 44 IBU

Sumptuous aromatics of juicy tropical fruits with pronounced orange flavor dominate this brew and the silky mouthfeel pulls it all together.

#11 Soundbite Cider - Everett, WA

1) La Paloma – ABV 5.9%

A Soundbite take on the classic cocktail. This one has a lot going on. Grapefruit juice, lime, sea salt, and a bit of blue agave to mellow it all out!

2) Everett Mule – ABV 6.2%

Crafted with ginger, cranberry and lime, our Everett Mule starts off with an earthy, spicy kick on the nose that belies its soft blush color. Juicy and tart on the first sip, there's just enough sweetness to wash it down smooth and leave you wanting another.

#12 Peace Of Mind Brewing – Lynnwood, WA

1) The Fixer Blonde- Blonde Ale: 6.5% ABV | 25 IBU

A classic blonde ale using Mosaic hops!

2) Galaxy Punk – Pilsner: 6% ABV | 32 IBU

A classic pilsner with a little more hoppiness to it using Galaxy Hops

3) Cloverfield – Hefeweizen

A classic hefeweizen that delights the palate with its refreshing blend of wheat and yeast, delivering a harmonious balance of banana and clove flavors.

4) State of Love and Haze – Hazy IPA

A captivating Hazy IPA infused with the harmonious trio of El Dorado, Citra, and Zythos hops, delivering a burst of tropical fruit aromas and a luscious citrusy taste.

#13 Locust Cider - Gig Harbor, WA

1) Imperial Pineapple Coconut – ABV 8.3%

Washington apples blended with pineapple juice and coconut, for a smooth tropical getaway

2) Watermelon - ABV 5%

Washington apples blended with watermelon juice

3) Berry Blues – ABV 6%

Washington apples blended with blueberry, hibiscus and vanilla. It is a light bodied with a blueberry flavor and a lot of underlying complexity.

#14 Whitewall Brewing Company - Marysville, WA

1) Czech Magnet – Amber Lager: ABV: 5%, IBU's 22

Czech style amber lager hints of caramel and just the right amount of hops to back up the malt. Super easy drinking lager.

2) Wheezin the Juice – Hazy IPA: ABV: 6.1%, IBU's: 53

The Wheez is back! This is the latest batch of our always popular hazy IPA and it's only getting better. With stiff amounts of Mandarin Bavaria and Azzaca hops and its big floral and citrus notes, this has quickly become our most popular IPA.

#15 Georgetown Brewing Company - Seattle, WA

1) The Nino Mexican Style Lager – 4.9% ABV

An updated version of our El Nino Lager, the Nino uses Zappa hops, a neomexicanus aroma hop that is a genetically distinct sub species from the dry mountain regions of New Mexico. An easy drinking, very light, crisp lager with a slightly sweet and grainy backbone.

2) Summerside IPA – 6.9% ABV

We're finally on this side of Summer, so it's a perfect time to release Summerside IPA. This time of year, ripe fruit is bursting at the seams so it's only right we brewed up a kitchen sink/fruit salad/what-do-we-do-with-all-these-hops IPA to make something fruity, juicy and fun!

3) You'll Get Nothing And Like It IPA – 6.9% ABV

When someone says, "You'll get nothing and like it," hope this is the beer they put in your hand. An unfiltered golden IPA with minimal bitterness, packed with aromas and flavors of pineapple, strawberry, ripened citrus and pine.

#16 Stitch Brewing – Mill Creek, WA

1) Soulshine - Wheat Ale: 6.2% ABV | 27 IBU

Summer in a glass! A refreshing wheat ale with loads of coriander and orange peel to make this a fantastic beer for the summer.

2) Dad-Bod - IPA: 6.8% ABV | 77 IBU

We all get them at some point. But this dad-bod is much better! Brewed with all Mosaic hops and then dry-hopped with another 5 lbs, this IPA crushes!

3) Regin City - IPA: 6.9% ABV | 78 IBU

Get on your magic carpet and ride! This West Coast IPA dunks on you with a blend of Amarillo, Centennial and Cascade hops that will remind you why the west coast is the BEST coast

4) 624 - Pale Ale: 6.8% ABV | 42 IBU

This OG is the one that started it all for us. A big pale brewed with tons of Amarillo and Cascade hops. This pale is crisp with a solid bitter finish!
